The challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is admittedly to show cause notice dated 08.01.2020 (Annexure P-6), in pursuance of resolution dated 24.12.2019 (Annexure P-5), whereby action is proposed to be taken under Rule 26 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Rules, 1963 for removal as Director of Nakodar Hindu Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd.

Admittedly, the petitioner has already replied to the said show cause notice, since appearance was to be put in on 28.01.2019. No order has yet been passed on the show cause notice which is alleged to be without jurisdiction. Even otherwise the said show cause notice has also been challenged before the Additional Chief Secretary-cum-Financial Commissioner, Punjab by way of filing the revision petition No.3 of 2020, which is now stated to be fixed for 27.03.2020 (stated to be wrongly typed, as it is fixed for 27.02.2020). In such circumstances, the present writ petition is premature as the proceedings may be dropped in view of the reply filed.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not press the present petition and prays for liberty to withdraw the same and to challenge any adverse order, if so passed.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty.
