The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner in his second attempt seeks grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.135 dated 19.03.2018 registered under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Sonipat.

Earlier petition bearing CRM-M No.49347 of 2019 was got dismissed as withdrawn by the petitioner on 03.12.2019.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

the trial of the case may take sufficient time in view of order of stay of trial passed in CRR No.3451 of 2019.

Since vide order of even date CRR No.3451 of 2019 has been dismissed, therefore, there is no ground to grant indulgence in this petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.
