Heard.

After carefully perusing the impugned orders passed by the Ld. trial Court as well as by the Court of Sessions, the matter is disposed off with liberty to the prosecution to secure attendance of all the forecited witnesses purely at their own risk. Thereafter, those witnesses shall be examined on one single effective date or on day to day basis, if not otherwise practicable for the Ld. trial Court.

Further respondent No.2 and other two accused would be entitled to payment of costs of Rs.3000/- each by the State. It is reported that the next date fixed before the trial Court happens to be this Saturday itself and in the circumstances, it may not be possible to secure attendance of all the four witnesses on that one specific date.

In such circumstances, let the Ld. trial Court fix an appropriate

convenient date for examination of the aforesaid material witnesses, if necessary on a day to day basis. But the costs payable by the State would be paid to the respondents before the trial Court on the date already fixed.
