The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Lady Constable Rajwinder Kaur, stated to be aged 26 years, has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 13.06.2019, registered under Sections 304-A IPC (Sections 465/468/471 IPC added later on) at Police Station Dugri, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 15.06.2020, passed by this Court, arrest of the petitioner has

been stayed.

On instructions from SI Rajandeep Singh, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

As such, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.06.2020, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
