Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.36 dated 08.04.2018 under Section 354-A IPC and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that it is on account of non-appearance on a single day i.e. 04.02.2020, petitioner who was otherwise on bail, his bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State. He states that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial court regularly.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

In case, petitioner surrenders before the trial court within a period of one week from today and files an application for grant of bail, he shall be admitted on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, however, subject to payment of ₹5,000/- as costs to be deposited by the petitioner with the Legal Services Authority, Punjab.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
