The petitioners have filed the present petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that parents of the petitioners have no objection to their marriage and have undertaken not to interfere in their married life and the petitioners do not want to continue with the petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn without prejudice to filing of fresh petition in case of apprehension of any danger from respondents No. 4 to 9.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
