1. Learned counsel contends that the non-official respondents do not fulfill the eligibility conditions for promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer and for that matter do not even fulfill the eligibility conditions for continuing on the post of Executive Engineer but still are being considered for promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer. Learned counsel further states that process for promoting the non-official respondents to the post of Superintending Engineer has been initiated with a recommendation to promote the said non-official respondents but no final decision has been taken on the same till date and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.1 and for directions being issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner in accordance with law.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only. Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit representation to respondent No.1 within one week from date of receipt of certified copy of order. In case any representation is submitted by the petitioner within the stipulated period of time, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.1 in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of the same.
