This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.461 dated 19.09.2017, under Sections 307, 341, 324, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention since 30.07.2019. In the meantime, Challan against him has already been submitted after completion of investigation. But, it transpires that the prosecution evidence has still to commence although as many as 32 witnesses have been cited in the Challan.

[3]. From the MLR available on record as Annexure P-2, it is clear that the injuries suffered by the victim were all simple in nature.

[4]. Co-accused, namely, Sajan @ Chaju has already been granted bail by this Court in CRM-M-16571-2020 on 14.07.2020 (Annexure A-1).

[5]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the

merits of the present case as a whole, and in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by keeping him in detention for an indefinite period, at this stage.

[6]. As such, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

[7]. Disposed off.
