GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

(1) At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner *inter alia*, has made a prayer to consider and finally decide the revision preferred by him in a time bound manner.

(2) Learned counsel for the petitioner also relies upon the order passed in **CWP No.3505 of 2020 (Sahib Singh vs. State of Punjab & Ors.)** which was disposed of on 10.02.2020.

(3) Counsel for the petitioner has urged that since the petitioner is facing the extreme consequence of termination from service, his revision petition deserves to be decided in a time bound manner. Moreover, the revision petition preferred by the petitioner is towards exhausting the statutory remedy.

(4) This Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition, without commenting on the merits of the case, with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director General of Police, Punjab to decide the revision petition preferred by the petitioner expeditiously but not later than two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
