The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.163 dated 25.05.2019, under Sections 148/149/302/307 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari, Haryana.

2. The petitioner was not named in the FIR. Admittedly, his name has transpired on record only from the disclosure statements of the other accused persons and there is no independent witness, who stated anything regarding involvement of the petitioner in the alleged occurrence. He would, therefore, appear to be treated at par with co-accused Dharambir, who was granted regular bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in

CRM-M-42508-2019 on 04.02.2020.

3. As such, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole as also considering the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time to complete in view of the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for releasing him on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

4. The present petition, along with all the pending applications, stand disposed off.
