GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Despite the matter having been called twice, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners.
2. The petitioners had approached this Court seeking issuance of directions for protection of their lives and they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 having married against their wishes.
3. Sh. R.K.Kashyap, Advocate, appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 has however, submitted that it is a case where his daughter i.e.

petitioner No.1 was aged less than 16 years at the time of her alleged marriage and had been enticed into the marriage by petitioner No.2.

4. Having perused the petition and having heard the learned counsel representing respondents No.4 and 5, it goes without saying that the petitioners in any case are entitled to live a safe and secure life. Even if petitioner No.1 had solemnized marriage against the wishes of her parents, her parents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 are not to cause any kind of harm to the petitioners. Learned counsel representing respondents No.4 and 5 has assured this court that they shall not take law into their hands.
5. In view of the aforestated position the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.2) to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners. Respondents No.4 and 5 are advised not to take law into their hands. The aforesaid directions are however, not to be construed to be conferring any kind of legality on the marriage of the petitioners or conferring any kind of immunity from any civil or criminal liability in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
6. The petition is disposed of in above mentioned terms.
