AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

By this petition the petitioners have challenged the action of the respondents in not deciding the claim for purchase of land in terms of Rule 12(4) of the Punjab Village Common Land Regulation & Rules 1964.

Learned State counsel states that one reason why the claim of the petitioners could not be decided was that the application had to be made to the Deputy Commissioner Sonapat-respondent No.2 but was addressed only to the Sarpanch.

Counsel for the petitioner has fairly accepted it and states that the petitioners will now move an application before respondent No.2 within a period of two weeks.

Learned State counsel states that if such an application is moved within two weeks, the same shall be decided within a period of two months thereafter.

Petition stands disposed of. Till then the petitioners be not dispossessed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
