This is a petition that has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 308 dated 15.9.2014 under Sections 354-A, 354-D, 509 IPC registered at Police Station Industrial area, Chandigarh and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent—State submits that since charges have been framed against the petitioner, therefore, no interference is called for in the instant petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, does not press the petition, but prays that the trial court be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

In view of the above statement, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to conclude the trial as early as possible, preferably within one year from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
