1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal Annexure P/5 dated 02.11.2019 etc. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal Annexure P/5 dated 02.11.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only. Ms. Safia Gupta, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed in the appeal, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the appeal Annexure P/5 dated 02.11.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
