Learned State counsel submits that the trial is near culmination as out of 25 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 24 have been examined.

Besides, the petitioner was taken to attend cremation of his father in custody. On the next day, i.e., 16.2.2020, he was also allowed to attend the bhog ceremony. According to him, application, thus, has been rendered infructuous. The petitioner remains unrepresented.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, this court is of the considered view that no cause of action survives in this application. Same is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
