Petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and not to interfere in their matrimonial life.

On 18.02.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. In response to the said order, she has produced copies of statements of the petitioners and respondent Nos.4 and 5 recorded separately. In their statements, petitioners have stated that they have no danger to their life and expressed that they do not need any protection from the police. Respondent Nos.4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.1) in their statements have stated that they have no objection to the marriage performed between the petitioners.

In view of the statements recorded by the police, learned counsel does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
