The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.16 dated 19.01.2020, under Sections 420, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D, 489-E and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 04.02.2020. No recovery was actually effected from him. The only available material against him appears to be the disclosure statement of some co-accused. Investigation has since been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified.

[4]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
