Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Ranjit Singh, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 292, dated 22.11.2018, registered under Sections 307/323/325/148/149 IPC, at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, when the first informant refused to hand over his mobile phone, he was brutally beaten up by 10 boys with iron rods and base ball bats.

The previous bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 08.11.2019 after considering the merits of the case.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of lock-down.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered view that learned counsel for the petitioner failed to make out any new ground for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in

custody since 24.11.2018, learned trial Court is requested to expedite the disposal of the trial.

Disposed of accordingly.
