Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.148 dated 18.09.2019, registered under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station City-1 Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Briefly, in the intervening night of 17.09.2019, petitioner alongwith his four accomplice, armed with deadly weapons, attacked the complainant and caused multiple injuries to him. Petitioner caused two rod blows to complainant i.e. one on back side of his head and another on left leg.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that both the injuries, attributed to petitioner, have been declared simple in nature. Main accused, who caused grievous injuries to complainant, are in judicial custody. Petitioner has falsely been implicated.

Considering the fact of attacking an empty handed person by five persons including petitioner armed with deadly weapons, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to petitioner.

Dismissed.
