The case has been taken up for hearing through
video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Section 438
Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 95
dated 27.06.2019 under Sections 307/ 34 IPC and Section 25
of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Bullowal District
Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.11.2020 on the
premise that the petitioner was nominated as an accused on the
basis of disclosure statement of Shahbaj Singh @ Shahu.
Petitioner has not been attributed any firing at the house of
Sahib Singh. Three persons have been shown as assailants,

whereas, five persons have been arrested and recoveries have been effected from them. Petitioner has nothing to do with those five persons, namely, Parminder Singh Ghor, Paras Sharma, Deepak @ Binny Gujjar, Jagdeep Singh @ Jaggu Bhagwanpuria and Shahbaj Singh @ Shahu.

In pursuance of the order dated 16.11.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel, on instructions from, ASI Kulwant Singh. Learned State counsel further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and he is not required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 16.11.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
