The petitioner is seeking promotion to the post of TGT English w.e.f. the date his juniors have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the instructions issued by the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana dated 25.03.2016 (Annexure P-2), if a candidate has higher qualification in the same line, he would be considered eligible and illustration has been given to explain that if the minimum qualification prescribed for a post is B.A. with English as an elective subject and a candidate has done B.A. with English as an elective subject and if a candidate having higher qualification M.A. in English, he would be eligible although the candidate may not have passed B.A. with English as an elective subject and have passed only simple B.A. without English as an elective subject.

In the present case, the petitioner has secured less than 50% marks in B.A. but she has more than 50% marks in M.A. English.

A detailed legal notice dated 31.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) has been sent to the respondents in this regard.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner for promotion and pass appropriate speaking orders on the legal notice dated 31.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) .
