This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 59 dated 11.3.2017 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 377, 34 IPC at Police Station Women Sector 51, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the parties are at ad idem that the matter has been settled amicably before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court by settlement dated 18.12.2019, wherein it has been decided by the parties in principle that divorce will be obtained under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, which was to be filed or before 7.1.2020 and it was further decided that an amount of ₹ 40 lakhs would be paid to the wife Dr.

Geetika Gupta in lieu of permanent alimony, maintenance and Istridhan.

In view of the fact that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties, anticipatory bail allowed to the petitioners herein stands confirmed subject to the parties complying with the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived between them.

The petition stands disposed of.
