At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer for issuance of direction to respondent No.5 to decide the Election Petition filed by the petitioner as the same has not been decided even after expiry of period of more than one year from the date of its filing. Learned counsel also submits that there is no delay on the part of the petitioner and a direction may be issued by this Court to decide the Election Petition within some time bound period.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5-State.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and having no objection from the other side, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to make all efforts to decide the Election Petition preferably within a period of six

weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
