Ms. Dhivya Jerath, Advocate has put in appearance and filed her Memorandum of Appearance on behalf of Respondents No.2 to 5, 7, 10, 11, 13, 14, 19 and 21, today in Court; Be kept with the record.

2. In compliance of earlier order dated 20.02.2020, Ld. State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Hoshiarpur, today in Court; Be kept with the record.

3. It transpires that there is some kind of Dharna by the mob outside the Gurudwara, which is the subject matter of the dispute. From Para No.7 of the Reply of the State, it is ascertained that adequate

Police arrangements have been made at the locale to prevent any untoward incident and to maintain law and order situation.

4. In view of the above reply, in the opinion of this Court, no direction needs to be passed in the matter. However, if the Petitioner has any other grievance against the mob gathered outside the Gurudwara, such as the alleged interference in the rights of the devotees to enter the Gurudwara or creation of nuisance at a public place, he is at liberty to seek any other appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
