The instant petition has been filed for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No. 2 herein in FIR No. 83 dated 28.09.2016 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh vide order dated 23.02.2017 by the Sessions Judge, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 opposes the cancellation of bail while learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that after the charges having framed far back, the matter is pending for recording of the statements of the prosecution witnesses and the trial is likely to conclude soon.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, no ground is made out for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2.
