A writ of mandamus is sought for issuance of directions to the respondent authorities to permit the petitioner to continue on such contractual engagement till such time regular appointments are not made.

Counsel has been heard.

This Court is of the considered view that no interference in the matter is warranted at this stage.

There is no material placed on record wherefrom this Court can infer that the petitioner is being relieved.

Essentially the prayer made in the instant petition is towards an attempt to secure a blanket order against relieving. No cause of action has accrued to the petitioner as of date.
