The grievance of the petitioner in this case is that the Reviewing Authority in the Punjab State Warehousing Corporation is not disposing of his review petition dated 25.06.2019 (Annexure P-8). The said review was preferred by the petitioner against the appellate order dated 29.08.2018 which was conveyed to him, vide letter dated 11.10.2018.

As it is for the Reviewing Authority to consider the aforestated review petition filed by the petitioner on its own merits and in accordance with law, no cause is made out for adjudication of the issues raised in this petition on merits at this stage.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Reviewing Authority in the Punjab State Warehousing Corporation to consider the petitioner's review petition (Annexure P-8) on its own merits and in accordance with law. The said review petition shall be disposed of by way of a reasoned order expeditiously and in any event, not later than two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Upon asking of the Court, Mr.Vikas Singh, learned counsel,

took notice for the respondent-Punjab State Warehousing Corporation and stated that he has no objection to the disposal of the writ petition on the above terms.
