(1) The petitioner *inter alia* prays for a direction to the respondent-Commission to grant him 4 marks for the Graduation as his re-evaluation result has been declared on 22.01.2019 which is prior to the date of scrutiny i.e. 15.02.2019 as the advertisement (P1) provides for 4 additional marks for higher degree and initial result of the petitioner was declared on 25.06.2018 which is prior to the last date of application for the post of Constable Male.

(2) Notice of motion was issued on 21.02.2019 and while noticing the facts, this Court directed that the respondents shall consider the result dated 22.01.2019 (P-11) of the petitioner and award him marks, as per criteria.

(3) A short reply has been filed on 30.09.2019 stating therein that the petitioner had applied for the post of Male Constable (General Duty)-IRB under the applied General category. The result of the written exam so conducted was declared on 07.02.2019. The petitioner qualified in the written exam and the Commission declared the final result for the post of 03.03.2019. It is averred by the respondents that the last selected candidate in the General category has secured 57.60 marks whereas the petitioner has

secured 51.40 marks. The submission on behalf of the State is that even if the petition was to be accepted and 4 marks was to be given, it would still be 55.40 marks i.e. much lesser than 57.60 marks obtained by the last candidate.

(4) In this view of the matter, no further order is called for.

(5) Dismissed.
