The present petition has been filed seeking writ of mandamus directing the respondent to de-freeze the cash credit accounts of the petitioner.

2. The argument raised is that these are zero or debit balance accounts and apart from this fact more than six months have elapsed yet even a copy of the attachment order has not been served. In our considered opinion, it would be more appropriate if the petitioner first approaches the respondent with the grievance because in the representation made the facts have been mentioned but the grievances have not been spelled out.

3. It is further directed in case the petitioner approaches the respondent within one week from the receipt of certified copy of this order reiterating all its grievances, respondent will pass a speaking order thereon, within 15 days.

4. Disposed of, accordingly.
