ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.2 has performed marriage with petitioner No.1 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Since in view of resolution of the Bar that due to sad demise of Dr. Jolly Sharma, Advocate, work shall remain suspended today i.e. 20.02.2020 in the post-lunch session, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

The petitioners have submitted that a representation dated 19.02.2020 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-5) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken

so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran is further directed to arrange a meeting of respondent No.4 with petitioner No.2 in case any such application is moved.

It is made clear that in case any FIR is registered against petitioner No.1, it will be open for the police authorities to take action, in accordance with law.
