The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.265 dated 23.11.2019, under Sections 21 & 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 02.01.2020. No recovery was directly effected from him but his name transpired from the disclosure statements of co-accused Davinder Kumar @ Pardeep and Deepak Raj @ Deepu, who had been found to be in possession of 4 and 6 grams of Heroin, respectively. The petitioner is reported to be involved in 4 other cases as mentioned in the custody affidavit sent up by Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot.

[3]. In addition, it is submitted that the petitioner is involved in 2 other cases under the N.D.P.S. Act, the particulars of which are presently not available. Be that as it may, in the present case, neither any recovery

was effected from him and even the contraband from the co-accused itself was admittedly of very small quantity.

[4]. As such, further detention of the petitioner in the present case is not called for, at this stage.

[5]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

[6]. Disposed off.
