The grievance of the petitioner is that although her request for carrying medication and additional food has been accepted, additional time has not been provided.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kannan Malik, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. The service upon respondent No.2 is dispensed with at this stage.

Mr. Kannan Malik, Advocate, appearing for respondent No.1 has filed a short reply which is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

As per the reply, circular dated 12.4.2019 of the CBSE does not permit provision of extra time to a student like the petitioner who is suffering from Type-I diabetes.

The vires of the aforementioned circular is not under challenge and, thus, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw

this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one to challenge the vires of circular dated 12.4.2019.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
