The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 62 dated 27.04.2018, registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala.

On 25.02.2020, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that he has instructions to say that the petitioners will not challenge the order passed by the trial Court under Section 319 Cr.P.C. summoning them as additional accused and will face the trial.

Notice of motion for 17.03.2020.

In the meantime, petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and they will be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 25.02.2020, have already appeared before

the trial Court and they have been released on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Swaran Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed order dated 25.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
