Petitioner has approached this Court impugning the show cause notice dated 28.01.2020 (Annexure P-15) which has been served upon her, whereby the petitioner has been called upon to submit an explanation/mention reasons, if any, contrary to what has been noted therein. Petitioner has filed reply to the said show cause reversion notice on 07.02.2020 (Annexure P-16).

2. As of now, there is no order of reversion which has been passed against the petitioner. This Court is sanguine that the competent authority shall go through the reply which has been filed by the petitioner to the reversion notice and keeping in view the factual position and the documents attached with the said reply, pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.

3. In view of the above facts, this Court is of the opinion that the writ petition at this stage is premature and, therefore, is disposed of as such.
