Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 17 dated 14.02.2020 registered under Section 61 Act No. 1 of Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that raid was conducted at the house of the petitioner on a secret information and 66 bottles of country-made liquor of Haryana has been recovered. The petitioner is first time offender.

Heard

It is a case, in which the house of the petitioner was raided and 66 bottles of country-made liquor of Haryana has been recovered. As per

prosecution, the petitioner is habitual of selling liquor in large quantity after taking it from State of Haryana.

In view of the above, no ground is made to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
