Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.107 dated 26.08.2019 under Sections 307, 452, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 27.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-49598-2019 and the order dated 11.12.2019 passed in CRM-M-51736-2019, vide which co-accused of the petitioner, namely Ashok Kumar and Vicky Mattu have already been granted the concession of regular bail, respectively. Learned counsel further relies upon the order dated 27.01.2020 passed in CRM-M-54708-2019, vide which co-accused Kamal Kumar has been granted the concession of anticipatory bail. It is submitted that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner, either of causing any injury to the complainant side or of firing towards them and the

allegations are against other co-accused. It is further submitted that the petitioner was arrested on 28.08.2019 and since then, he is in custody; challan stands presented and conclusion of the trial will take some time.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2019; he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial will take some time and also in view of the fact that his aforesaid co-accused have already been released on regular/anticipatory bail, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
