This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.64 dated 11.10.2019, under Sections 323, 506, 34 and 307 (added later on), registered at Police Station, Arif Ke, District Ferozepur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel contends that the misunderstanding developed between the parties have now been sorted out as they have compromised the matter with the intervention of respectable persons and Panchayat members. He has invited the attention of the Court to the compromise/affidavit dated 25.11.2019 (Annexure P-2).

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to accept the sole ground of compromise set up by the petitioners for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. considering the nature of offences and the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019 AIR (SC) 1296.**

Dismissed.
