Result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/DHBVNL against Advertisement No.3/2016 (Category No.03) in SC Category has been produced in sealed cover alongwith the cut off marks obtained by the last selected candidate in the respective category.

2. On opening the sealed cover, result of the petitioner reveals him to have secured 75 marks out of total of 200 as against the last selected candidate in UHBVNL/DHBVNL having secured 79/78 marks respectively.

3. The result as well as cut off marks obtained by the last selected candidate have been shown to learned counsel for the petitioner, who, on perusal thereof, states that he does not wish to press the writ petition.

5. As per the stand of learned Sr. DAG, Haryana, there is no waiting list for the SC category.

6. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is dismissed as not pressed.

7. Result be resealed and returned to learned Sr. DAG, Haryana.
