Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.1238 dated 21.12.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A, 452, 365, 506, 511 IPC (further charges have been framed under Sections 363, 366-A, 451, 506, 309 IPC), registered at Police Station City Sirsa, Sirsa.

Learned State Counsel has apprised this Court that as against total 14 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 12 witnesses have been examined and the case is now fixed for 17.03.2020 before the trial court for remaining evidence on which date 02 PWs are to be examined.

Case being at advanced stage of trial, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Dismissed.

Petitioner being in custody since 22.12.2018, the trial Court

shall make an endeavour to expedite the trial.

However, in case petitioner needs the services of a Legal Aid Counsel and he approaches the District Legal Services Authority, the Legal Services Authority shall provide him the services of a Legal Aid Counsel.
