By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to regularize his services as per the instructions dated 07.03.1996.

This petition was admitted on 10.03.1997 with further direction that services of the petitioner were not to be terminated except consequent upon any disciplinary proceedings. Thereafter on 07.05.1997, learned counsel for the State has informed that there was no move to terminate the services of the petitioner and if services were to be terminated, the petitioner would be given 10 days notice.

Keeping in view order dated 07.05.1997, no further direction is required to be given at this stage as neither learned counsel for the petitioner nor learned counsel for the State has information with respect to status of the service conditions of the petitioner.

Hence, this writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to get this order recalled within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, if any cause of action survives.
