Reply by way of affidavit of Krishan Gopal Aggarwal,
Advocate on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and 8 has been filed in the
Court and the same is taken on record.

Main case

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for
issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to produce the status report of
action taken in DDR No.28 dated 10.10.2018 registered under Section 323
IPC, at Police Station City South, Moga, District Moga.

Notice of motion was issued on 26.02.2019.

Pursuant to the order dated 26.02.2019, status report by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed, wherein it has been mentioned that on 08.10.2018, after calling the petitioner in the Principal room, private respondents gave him beating. Thereafter, petitioner called his brother who got him admitted in Civil Hospital, Moga. After the medical check up of the petitioner, MLR was issued and only offence punishable under Section 323 IPC was made out.

As per the allegations in the complaint, the DDR was recorded which does not disclose commission of any cognizable offence and therefore, no FIR was registered.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C particularly when the alternative remedy is available with the petitioner.

Petition stands dismissed.
