[1] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is shown to have secured 99 out of 200 marks for selection to the post of Lower Division Clerk and has also been treated as ineligible.

[2] Learned counsel for the respondents has produced result of the petitioner for the post of LDC against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 for UHBVNL/DHBVNL in a sealed cover in Court today which on opening reveals the petitioner to have secured 86 marks in the written examination and 13 marks in the viva voce total 99 marks out of 200 for selection to the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 of UHBVNL/DHBVNL but of having been treated ineligible on account of not possessing diploma in Computers from HARTRON. Learned State Counsel on the other hand states that the question of eligibility pales into

insignificance in view of the last selected candidate in the General Category under which the petitioner had applied having secured 113/117 marks for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/DHBVNL respectively whereas the petitioner secured only 99 marks.

[3] Result of the petitioner as well as cut-off marks of the last selected candidate have been shown to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal states that he does not press the writ petition at this stage.

[4] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is dismissed as not calling for any further orders at this stage.

[5] All pending misc. applications are also disposed of.
