Vide order dated 02.04.2019, this Court had observed that learned counsel for the appellants would either implead the LRs of respondents, who have died during pendency of the appeal or address arguments in the alternative for their non-impleadment.

Today, learned counsel for the appellants submits that despite her endeavours, she has not been able to seek instructions from the appellants and is, therefore, unable to effectively assist this Court and also unable to take any steps to implead the LRs of respondents, who have died during pendency of the appeal.

By sheer pendency of the appeal for more than 29 years before this Court seems to have either rendered it infructuous or even otherwise the appellants seem to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

Regular Second Appeal is, accordingly, dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the appellants to file an application, in case, any cause of action still survives.
