The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to conduct inquiry into the complaint/representation dated 14.9.2019 (Annexure P-1) pending before respondents No.4 and 5 for the last about 5 months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although he had submitted an application dated 14.9.2019 (Annexure P-1) to Director General of Police, Punjab as well as to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, highlighting the irregularities conducted by the stamp vendor Jatinder Kumar and others and the tampering in the Register of the

Stamp Vendor but till date no action has been taken on his application and the same has remained undecided.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the allegations levelled in the complaint (Annexure P-1), the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Jalandhar Rural, Jalandhar (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to ensure that the complaint/application dated 14.9.2019 (Annexure P-1) is disposed of expeditiously in accordance with law, in case the same has not already been disposed of.

A copy of this order along with copy of complaint/application Annexure P-1 be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Jalandhar Rural, Jalandhar (respondent No.3), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
