In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for promoting him as Head Master w.e.f. the date the person junior to him was promoted.

Learned counsel for the respondents argues that according to the State, no person, who was junior to the petitioner has been promoted in preference to the petitioner, which will cause prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in order to seek instructions from the petitioner, she tried to contact the petitioner but failed and therefore, she does not have any instruction at this stage to pursue the matter.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, in case any of the grievances raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition still survives.
