This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 07.05.2018, under Sections 307, 332, 333, 353, 186, 148, 149 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 19.03.2019 and has remained in detention thereafter. In the meantime, challan against him has already been submitted after completion of investigation. It further transpires from Affidavits of HC Amarjit Singh, complainant, and HC Janta Singh, injured, Annexure P-4 (Colly.) that by now the petitioner and injured have amicably compromised the dispute with the complainant/victim. In the totality of the circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is

not justified, at this stage.

[3]. For the aforesaid reasons and considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
