Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.59 dated 27.09.2019 registered under Sections 420 IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Airport, District Amritsar City.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody since 22.10.2019 and as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner has provided fake Visas to the victim. It is further submitted that the petitioner to show her bona fide is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.2 lacs before the trial Court, without prejudice to her right of defence to be taken up during the course of trial.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer has, however, submitted that there is one more FIR registered against the petitioner.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 22.10.2019; the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and the petitioner

undertake to deposit a sum of Rs.2 lacs before the trial Court, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The amount of Rs.2 lacs, if so deposited, will be kept in an FDRs subject to final outcome of the case, without prejudice to the right of the petitioner.

The deposit of amount of Rs.2 lacs shall be a pre-condition before accepting the bail/surety bonds of the petitioner.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, in case she is found involved in any other case or misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
