Both the above mentioned petitions shall stand decided by this common order as the petitioner(s) are accused in the same FIR bearing No.166 dated 12.07.2019.

Both the present petitions are filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner(s) in case FIR No.166 dated 12.07.2019 under Sections 307/34/458 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act (later on converted into Section 306/34 of IPC), registered at Police Station, Sector-6, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner (s) submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition(s) with liberty to surrender before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

However, in case, the petitioner(s) surrender before the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate within one week' from today, the concerned Court shall decide the bail applications of the petitioners within 10 days from the date of their surrender before the trial Court.
