Prayer is to grant bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 13 dated 16.1.2019 registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He draws attention of the Court to order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge dated 20.12.2012 directing the concerned Telecom operators/Telecom Companies to preserve the aforesaid call details and tower location of the mobile numbers mentioned in the application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the aforesaid details from the Telecom Company be requisitioned which would prove that the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

On a Court's question, learned counsel for the petitioner admitted that no application before the Court below has been filed requesting the Court to consider the prayer for bail on examination of the

record of call details and tower location.

In these circumstances, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the Trial Court. This Court has no doubt that the learned Trial Court would decide the same in accordance with law within one month.
