ARUN MONGA, J.

Present second appeal has been preferred by the plaintiff-appellant. The trial Court had decreed his suit and directed that defendants shall consider the plaintiff to be in continuous service from 14.07.1997 without backwages and consider his back services for promotion and pensionary benefits vide judgment dated 20.08.1988. Subsequently in the first appeal filed by the plaintiff his claim for backwages was dismissed and cross-appeal filed by State of Haryana was partly accepted and appellant/plaintiff was allowed to continue as work charged employee not as regular vide judgement dated 07.06.1990. The instant regular second appeal was filed sometime in the year 1990 and was admitted vide order dated 24.08.1990. No interim relief was allowed to appellant at the time of admission. Given sheer efflux of time for more than 30 years since the original suit was instituted on 29.11.1986, this Court is of the opinion that the relief sought by the appellant herein has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to
appellant to file appropriate application in case any cause of action still
survives.
